Alexander Fleming (1881-1955) In 1928, a forgotten Petri dish in Fleming's lab bloomed with mould - and changed the history of medicine. He realized that the mould had produced a self-defence chemical that prevented bacteria around it from growing. He called this substance 'penicillin', and it was later developed by Howard Florey and Ernst Chain into the world's first life-saving antibiotic
